Flood Safety

In the event of a flood certain
precautions should be taken:

- Never walk through water.
Drowning is the number one
cause of flood deaths, especially
during flash floods.
- Do not drive through a flood-ed
area. More people drown in their
cars than anywhere else. Don't
drive around barriers. This
means the road is closed to all
traffic and you are subject to a
citation.
- Stay away from power lines and
electrical lines. The number two
flood killer, after drowning, is
electrocution. Some appliances,
such as television sets keep
electrical charges even after they
have been unplugged.
- Look out for animals, especially
snakes. Small animals that have
been flooded out of their homes
may seek shelter in yours.
- Clean everything that gets wet.

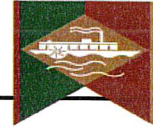
